Sow, Grow and Farm

- I can tell you about farming in the UK (factors effecting it and the different types)
- I can locate places (local farms) in the landscape (using six-figure grid references)
- I can describe what a climate zone is (and describe the six main types)
- I can discuss different types of farming from around the world (citrus farming in California and coffee farming in Peru).

Investigating Our World

- I understand what time zones (and can work out the time of different places from around the world).
- I can tell you what a vegetation belt is (and describe the different features of these).
- I can describe, in detail, a major city from around the world (Wellington, Washington DC, Vienna, Kuala Lumpur, Cairo and Buenos Aires).
- I know what sustainability means (and can link this to manufacturing processes)

Frozen Kingdom

- I can describe what the Arctic, North and South Poles are (the natural resources found there, features of these regions & the people who live there).
- I can explain what climate change is (including the causes and impact of global warming and the greenhouse effect).
- I can describe tourism in Antarctica (and how this has changed this place over time).

Our Changing World

- I can find the position of significant lines of latitude and longitude (the Equator, Prime Meridian, Tropic of Cancer, Tropic of Capricorn, Arctic Circle and Antarctic Circle).
- I can use degrees of longitude and latitude to find positions (cities from around the world).
- I can explain how trade from around the world happens (including exporting and the effect on a countries economy, using case studies of everyday items).
- I can use fieldwork to answer a question about a local and national issue (road safety).
