- I enjoy sharing books with an adult and respond to the pictures and words.
- I can talk about events and characters in a story read to me.

 using my own words and recently introduced vocabulary during discussions about stories, nonfiction and rhymes.
- I am familiar with a range of texts, particularly our core texts.
- I can read individual letters by saying the sounds for them.
- I can blend sounds into words, so that I can read short words made up of known letter-sound correspondences.
- I can read at least 10 digraphs e.g. sh, th, ch.
- I can read a few common exception words matched to the RWI programme e.g. I, the.
- I can read aloud simple sentences and books that are consistent with my phonic knowledge,
 including some common exception words.
